ABOUT GRENADA

Grenada is an island state in the South East Caribbean Sea. The island is known as the "Spice of the Caribbean", offering a pure, authentic lifestyle and a warm climate. Grenada has smaller surrounding islands that boast crystal clear waters, white sandy beaches, unspoilt landscapes and the most beautiful coral reefs.

Grenada's official language is English with a minority of its citizens speaking French-African Patois.

The Grenadian government reconstituted its immigration policies in 2013 to encourage foreign investment, allowing applicants to obtain a Grenadian citizenship-through-investment in only 4-6 months.

Grenada is a member of the Commonwealth, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States, Association of Caribbean States, Non-Aligned Movement, Organisation of Eastern Caribbean States, Organisation of American States, United Nations and World Trade Organisation.

TRAVEL WITH EASE

As a citizen of Grenada, you can travel to over 146 countries visa-free. This list includes the UK and all Schengen states, as well as important business hubs like Singapore and Hong Kong.

Furthermore, Grenada is one of the very few nations whose citizens do not require a visa to travel to the People's Republic of China.

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF NEW BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES

Grenadian passport holders benefit from its stable financial environment and its attractive tax regime. The island has no foreign income tax, inheritance tax, capital gains tax, wealth tax or gift tax and it allows duty-free trading throughout the Caribbean.

Another great advantage includes the ability to apply for a USA E-2 Visa. This enables you to relocate and start your business in the United States of America in exchange for an investment.

SECURE YOUR FAMILY'S FUTURE

Your spouse, dependent children (below the age of 30), dependent parents and siblings can apply to obtain their Grenada passports along with you with the option to relocate and work in any Caribbean Community (CARICOM) country.

You and your family are not required to live in Grenada to obtain citizenship, meaning you can apply for and receive secondary passports without having to relocate the entire family or renounce your original nationality.

Another great advantage includes your children receiving a 90% reduction in tuition fees, as Grenadian citizens, in Saint George's University. This is a world-renowned university for medical programmes and number one foreign provider of doctors into the US healthcare system.

INVESTMENT OPTIONS

There are 2 investment options which serve as a qualifier for the Grenadian citizenship-by-investment programme:

OPTION 1

National Transformation Fund (NTF) Contribution

- Main applicant: **USD 150,000.**
- Family of up to 4 (spouse and children only): **USD 200,000.**
- Each additional dependent child or parent/grandparent (above 55 years): **USD 25,000.**
- Each additional parent/grandparent (below 55 years): **USD 50,000.**
- Each additional dependent sibling: **USD 75,000.**

(Contribution is non-refundable).

OPTION 2

Real Estate Investment

Minimum investment in an approved real estate project:

USD 220,000.

(Additional government fees apply).

PROCESS AND TIMELINE

Month 1 Preparation Sign a retainer agreement for Next Generation Equity to act as your legal advisor for the citizenship application and legal process.

Prepare required documentation.

Payment of government fees, due diligence, citizenship application and legal fees.

Submission of the citizenship application

*For the real estate investment option, you are required to reserve a property in advance.

Month 2-4 Citizenship application Government due diligence process.
Citizenship approval is issued.

Month 5-6 Receive Grenadian citizenship Upon receiving your citizenship approval, you can continue with your selected investment option:

- Make the National Transformation Fund (NTF) contribution. The payment will be made directly to the government.
- Proceed with the complete purchase of real estate. The payment will be made directly to the developer's escrow account.

Take the Oath of Allegiance.

Citizenship Certificate of Registration is issued.

Grenada passport is granted thereafter.

* The time estimated to receive the citizenship approval is based on the government's due diligence processing time and may vary.
